WHO WE ARE

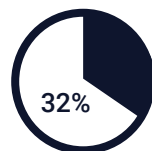

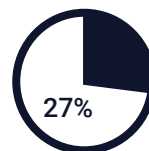

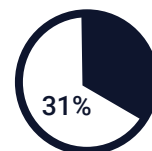
